ORDINANCE NO. 1783

AN ORDINANCE establishing a maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour on Southwest 106th Place, Southwest 107th Street, and amending Ordinance 1100, Schedule 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Traffic Code, Ordinance 1100, Schedule 2, which establishes a maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour on county roads, as authorized by RCW 46.61.415, is amended to add the following location:

SOUTHWEST 106TH PLACE, SOUTHWEST 107TH STREET, between 16th Avenue Southwest and 26th Avenue Southwest.

SECTION 2. Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.
