

ORDINANCE NO. 1790

AN ORDINANCE recognizing unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$50,790 from Junior Taxing Districts and appropriating \$50,790 to the Department of Assessments, amending Section 2, Ordinance No. 1431, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Unanticipated revenue from Junior Taxing Districts in the amount of \$50,790 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Assessments.

SECTION 2. Section 2, Ordinance No. 1431, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Assessments ((~~\$8,088,290~~)) \$3,139,080

SECTION 3. The Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
