INITIAL PROCESSING - ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Ordinances and motions shall be drafted in conformance with drafting guide lines prepared by the office of the ((Administrator-Glerk))

Clerk of the Council.

Proposed ordinances or motions must be filed with the ((Administrator-Glerk)) Clerk of the Council and introduced by Council member.
