ORDINANCE NO. 1814

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 1796 establishing a Head Start administrative organization and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1796, Section 3, is hereby amended to read as follows:

((There-is-established-an-interim-erganization-known-as-the Head-Start-Administrative-Group-within-the-Department-of Gemmunity-and-Environmental-Development-eensisting-of-a-Head Start-Director-and-staff-necessary-to-administer-the-Gounty-Head Start-Program)).

There is established a Head Start Administrative Group consisting of a Head Start Director and staff necessary to administer the joint Seattle-King County Head Start Program.

The Director shall be hired by the Policy Board established by Section 4 of Ordinance 1796 in accordance with H.E.W. directives. The Administrative Group shall be subject to the direction of the Policy Board and will be accountable to the Policy Board.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1796, Section 4, is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is established a City-County Head Start Policy Board consisting of two persons appointed by the Seattle City Council, two persons appointed by the County Council, two appointed by the Mayor of the City of Seattle from City departments and two appointed by the King County Executive from County departments.

One of the persons appointed by the County Executive shall be from the Department of Community and Environmental Development, which department shall have the principal responsibility for the County's administrative participation. The Chairman of the Policy Board shall be selected from the members appointed by the Seattle City or King County Councils.

The Policy Board shall have authority in areas of program management, approval of delegate agency plans and budgets, and

1 selection and supervision of Head Start central administrative staff, all in accordance with H.E.W. regulations and guidelines; provided that the annual plan and budget for the overall Head Start program and the designation of delegate agencies shall be approved by the governments of King County and the City of Seattle by ordinance. The Policy Board shall report to the Seattle City and King County Councils with recommendations for permanent placement of the Headstart Administrative Group by December 1, 1973. SECTION 3. NEW SECTION. There is added to Ordinance 1796 a new section to read as follows: King County agrees with the City of Seattle to establish

and operate jointly a Head Start program to be known as "Seattle-King County Head Start Program" with King County as the legal grantee.

There is added to Ordinance 1796 SECTION 4. NEW SECTION. 'a new section to read as follows:

This ordinance shall constitute the agreement between the City of Seattle and King County upon adoption by the City of Seattle of an ordinance of like effect and shall be reviewed by the Seattle City and King County Council no later than August 1, 1974.
