

ORDINANCE NO.: 1814

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 1796 estab-
2 lishing a Head Start administrative organization
and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. Ordinance 1796, Section 3, is hereby amended
5 to read as follows:

6 ~~((There is established an interim organization known as the
7 Head Start Administrative Group within the Department of
8 Community and Environmental Development consisting of a Head
9 Start Director and staff necessary to administer the County Head
10 Start Program)).~~

11 There is established a Head Start Administrative Group con-
12 sisting of a Head Start Director and staff necessary to
13 administer the joint Seattle-King County Head Start Program.
14 The Director shall be hired by the Policy Board established by
15 Section 4 of Ordinance 1796 in accordance with H.E.W. directives.
16 The Administrative Group shall be subject to the direction of
17 the Policy Board and will be accountable to the Policy Board.

18 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1796, Section 4, is hereby
19 amended to read as follows:

20 There is established a City-County Head Start Policy Board
21 consisting of two persons appointed by the Seattle City Council,
22 two persons appointed by the County Council, two appointed by the
23 Mayor of the City of Seattle from City departments and two ap-
24 pointed by the King County Executive from County departments.
25 One of the persons appointed by the County Executive shall be
26 from the Department of Community and Environmental Development,
27 which department shall have the principal responsibility for
28 the County's administrative participation. The Chairman of the
29 Policy Board shall be selected from the members appointed by the
30 Seattle City or King County Councils.

31 The Policy Board shall have authority in areas of program
32 management, approval of delegate agency plans and budgets, and
33

1 selection and supervision of Head Start central administrative
2 staff, all in accordance with H.E.W. regulations and guidelines;
3 provided that the annual plan and budget for the overall Head
4 Start program and the designation of delegate agencies shall be
5 approved by the governments of King County and the City of
6 Seattle by ordinance. The Policy Board shall report to the
7 Seattle City and King County Councils with recommendations for
8 permanent placement of the Headstart Administrative Group by
9 December 1, 1973.

10 SECTION 3. NEW SECTION. There is added to Ordinance 1796
11 a new section to read as follows:

12 King County agrees with the City of Seattle to establish
13 and operate jointly a Head Start program to be known as "Seattle-
14 King County Head Start Program" with King County as the legal
15 grantee.

16 SECTION 4. NEW SECTION. There is added to Ordinance 1796
17 a new section to read as follows:

18 This ordinance shall constitute the agreement between the
19 City of Seattle and King County upon adoption by the City of
20 Seattle of an ordinance of like effect and shall be reviewed by
21 the Seattle City and King County Council no later than August 1,
22 1974.
