ORDINANCE NO. 1815

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as the #69-24 Annexation Area to Southwest Suburban Sewer District.

WHEREAS, Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, has found the petition for annexation of an area known as the #69-24 Annexation Area to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for sewer facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, of the area known as the #69-24 Annexation Area and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as the #69.24 Annexation Area to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

Thence Northerly along the West line of the said SE 1/4 to its intersection with the centerline of Renton-Three Tree Point Road as established by King County Survey 2649;

Thence Easterly along said centerline to its intersection with the East line of the West 660 feet of the said SE 1/4;

Thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection with the South line of the said SE 1/4 (Centerline of S. 160th St.); Thence Westerly along said South line to the said Southwest corner of the SE 1/4 and the Point of Beginning.
