AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Lake Washington School District No. 414 to Sahalee Sewer District, King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, Sahalee Sewer District, King County, Washington, has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Lake Washington to be sufficient and has by Resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for sewer facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Sahalee Sewer District of the area known as Lake Washington School District No. 414 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Lake Washington School District No. 414 to be annexed is described as follows:

The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 6 E.W.M.; EXCEPT the south 330 feet of the east 660 feet, and EXCEPT the west 130 feet of the north 130 feet of the south 290 feet; and EXCEPT the west 30 feet of the south 160 feet.
