ORDINANCE NO. 1821

AN ORDINANCE relating to reorganization and consolidation of King County Departments and Administrative Offices and amending Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (a) and Subsection (3), and K.C.C. 2.16.040 and K.C.C. 2.16.080, and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (a) and K.C.C. 2.16.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Department of public works and transportation -- Duties -- Divisions. The department of public works and transportation shall be responsible for the administration of the divisions of engineering, solid waste, airport, hydraulics, other related utility, public works and transportation functions. The department shall be composed of the following divisions:

- (1) ENGINEERING DIVISION. The engineering division shall be responsible for the administration of the county roads and streets system, including road/street design, construction, ((and)) maintenance programs, and the administration and operation of Engineering and Central Automotive functions.
- (2) AIRPORT DIVISION. The airport division shall be responsible for the administration of King County Airport(s), including the implementation of county policy regarding airport development, the enforcement of King County Code rules and regulations regarding airport operations, and the administration of the fiscal and operating activities of county airport(s).
- (3) SOLID WASTE DIVISION. The solid waste division shall be responsible for the administration of the county solid waste program which provides for the disposal and recycling of solid waste for King County households and industries.
- (4) HYDRAULICS DIVISION. The hydraulics division shall be responsible for the administration of county surface water management programs, including construction and maintenance programs which implement county policy as it relates to the regulation of drainage and the prevention of floods.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (3) and K.C.C. 2.16.080 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Department of executive administration -- Divisions. The department of executive administration shall be under the direction of the county administrative officer and shall include the following:

- (1) COMPTROLLER DIVISION. The comptroller division shall prescribe the accounting procedures to be used by the county after coordination with the budget division, shall collect all county revenue and shall make all disbursements, and investment of county funds.
- (2) PERSONNEL DIVISION. The personnel division shall have the responsibilities established by Article 5 of the Charter and shall perform any other duties assigned to it by the county administrative officer.
- (3) SYSTEMS SERVICES DIVISION. The systems services division shall establish and maintain a modern system for processing information in accordance with the needs of county government.
- chasing division shall assign the use of all real and personal property owned or leased by the county, shall maintain all property unless its maintenance is otherwise assigned by the Charter, by ordinance, or by the county executive, shall negotiate the lease or sale of county property, shall contract for all services and public works which are not performed by county employees and shall purchase all real and personal property purchased by the county.
- (5) RECORDS AND ELECTIONS DIVISION. The records and elections division shall record, file and register all documents presented to it which by general law may be recorded, filed and registered to provide constructive legal notice and all other documents specified by ordinance; shall maintain the county archives to store all county records which should not be destroyed and which are not necessary for the current operation of county government; shall be responsible for the registration of voters in the county; and shall conduct all special and general elections held in the county.
 - (6) GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION. The general services division

shall administer regulations of the county requiring business, motor vehicle, j and marriage licenses, shall administer functions related to licensing, 2 veterans, and control of animals, and other functions assigned by the county 3 administrative officer. 4 ((FAGILITIES-AND-AUTOMOTIVE-SERVICES-DIVISION)) 5 (7) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT DIVISION. The facilities ((and 6 automotive-services)) management division shall be responsible for the manage 7 8 ment of county facilities and ((the-operation-of-central-automotive-functions)) 9 provide management in the King County Automotive Center. 10 SECTION 3.-- NEW SECTION.
