AN ORDINANCE establishing a No Shooting area in the TWIN LAKES PRECINCT; and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

A new section is added to K.C.C. NEW SECTION. SECTION 1.

12.68 to read as follows:

The shooting of firearms is hereby prohibited in the Twin Lakes Precinct, described as:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of 47th Ave. S.W. also known as F.B. Hoyt Road S.W. and the centerline of S.W. 320th St.; thence easterly along the centerline of S.W. 320th St. to the centerline intersection of 36th Ave. S.W.; thence southerly to the north-east corner of Lot 171 of Twin Lakes No. 2 as recorded in Vol. 79 of Plats, pages 32 to 37, Records of King County, Washington; thence south along the east line of said Lot 171 and its southerly extension to the centerline of S.W. 325th St.; thence westerly along said centerline and continuing southwesterly along the centerline of 39th Place S.W. and the centerline of 40th Ave. S.W. to the centerline of S.W. 328th St.; thence west along the centerline of S.W. 328th St. a distance west along the centerline of S.W. 320th St. a distance of 128 feet to a point on the west line of the plat of Twin Lakes No. 3 (Vol. 82, pages 42 to 44); thence south along said west line to the centerline of Section 14, Twp. 21 N., Range 3 E., W.M.; thence west along said centerline to the centerline of 47th Ave. S.W.; thence northerly along the centerline of 47th Ave. S.W. to the centerline of S.W. 320th St. and the point of beginning centerline of S.W. 320th St. and the point of beginning.
