2 AN ORDINANCE relating to per diem for the  
3 Board of Appeals, amending K.C.C. 2.32.090  
4 and Ordinance No. 909, Section 1.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. K.C.C. 2.32.090 and Ordinance No. 909

7 Section 1, are amended to read as follows: Board of appeals on  
8 property taxes and business licenses -- Per diem allowance. (a)  
9 In conformity with the new specifications of Chapter 55, 41st  
10 Legislature, 2nd Extra Session, and in addition to those powers  
11 relating to valuation provided for in Charter Section 720, the  
12 board of appeals shall hear and decide all appeals and such other  
13 matters specified by RCW 84.48.010 (relating to the July board  
14 of equalization) RCW 84.56.390, RCW 84.56.400 (relating to the  
15 treasurer's June board of equalization), and RCW 84.52.090 (re-  
16 lating to the assessor's November board of equalization) as  
17 amended to July 1, 1970. Any member disqualified by Section 3  
18 of said Chapter 55 may obtain temporary leave of absence by order  
19 of the county executive or his designee in the premises.

20 (b) The board of appeals shall hear and decide all  
21 appeals resulting from the denial, suspension or revocation of  
22 business licensing.


23 (c) For time devoted to the official work of the  
24 board of appeals, each member thereof shall receive a per diem  
25 allowance of ((thirty-five)) fifty dollars provided, that a per  
26 diem allowance of seventeen dollars and fifty cents shall be paid  
27 for official board work of three hours or less. This shall be

2 allowance shall revert to thirty-five dollars.




