

ORDINANCE NO. 1856

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$110,000 of anticipated fund balances available in the 1973 appropriations for Superior Court and Judicial Administration to the Juvenile Court to cover required 1973 expenditures; amending Ordinance No. 1431, Section 2, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$110,000 is hereby approved and adopted to the Juvenile Court, Current Expense Fund from offsetting reductions in 1973 appropriations to the Superior Court and Judicial Administration.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1431, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:



Judicial Administration	(( <del>\$1,170,384</del> ))	<u>\$1,112,149</u>

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.




