ORDINANCE NO. 1870

AN ORDINANCE revising the 1973 appropriations to the Council Administrator and the County Auditor, amending Ordinance No. 1431, Section 2, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$2,500 is hereby approved and adopted to the Council Administrator to fund salary and fringe benefit costs in the Seattle King County Office of Citizen Complaints through December 15, 1973, from the 1973 appropriation to the County Auditor.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1431, Section 2, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

Council Administrator	((\$134,928))	<u>\$136,828</u>
County Auditor	((\$178,744))	<u>\$176,244</u>

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
