

ORDINANCE 1881

1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$5,686
2 to the Public Health Pooling Fund to
3 fund milk inspection program for January,
4 1974, amending Ordinance No. 1859, Section
5 3 and declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$5,686 from
8 estimated but unappropriated 1974 revenue to the Public Health
9 Pooling Fund is hereby approved and adopted. This appropriation
10 shall fund the County's portion of Seattle-King County Health
11 Department milk inspection program for January, 1974.

12 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 3, as amended, is
13 hereby amended to read as follows:

14 Public Health Pooling ((\$4,408,649)) \$4,414,335

15 SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
16 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
17 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
18 or for the support of county government and its existing public
19 institutions.
