

ORDINANCE NO. 1882

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an
3 area known as Annexation No. 36 to the North-
east Lake Washington Sewer District.

4 WHEREAS, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer District has found
5 the petition for annexation of an area known as Annexation No. 36
6 to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the
7 proposed annexation; and

8 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexa-
9 tion by the King County Council and the King County Boundary
10 Review Board; and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is
12 in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county
13 comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan and the county plan
14 for sewer facilities;

15 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. The annexation by Northeast Lake Washington
17 Sewer District of the area known as Annexation No. 36 and
18 described in Section 2 herein is approved.

19 SECTION 2. The area known as Annexation No. 36 to be
20 annexed is described as follows:

22 All that portion of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 7,
23 T. 26 N., R. 5 E., W.M. lying south of the centerline of
24 the channel of the Sammamish River, more particularly
described as follows:

25 Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast 1/4
26 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 7, Township 26 North,
27 Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, said Southwest
corner being on the east boundary of the Northeast
Lake Washington Sewer District and the true point of
beginning;

28 Thence Northerly along West boundary of the said North-
29 east 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 to the centerline of the
Sammamish River as it now exists;

1 Thence Easterly and Southerly along the centerline of
2 the channel of the Sammamish River to the South boundary
3 of the said Northeast 1/4 of the Wouthwest 1/4 of Sec-
tion 7;

4 Thence Westerly along said South boundary to the true
point of beginning.

5 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 3rd day of
6 December, 1973.
