

ORDINANCE NO. 1902

AN ORDINANCE relating to a system of compensation for the use of privately owned vehicles for County business.

PREAMBLE:

It is the intent of the Council to seek increased efficiency in the use of County vehicles and to maintain at a minimum the number of permanently assigned County vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. NEW SECTION. The executive, legislative and judicial branches of County government may, at their individual option, establish a system of reimbursement on a monthly allotment basis for use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with County business in lieu of permanently assigned County vehicles.

SECTION 2. NEW SECTION. Said compensation shall not exceed 80% of the average monthly charge billed by the Motor Pool for equivalent vehicles.
