ORDINANCE NO. 1912

AN ORDINANCE relating to special control areas, establishing Flood Hazard Areas, and applying Ordinance 1527 to land along portions of Cedar, Tolt and Snoqualmie Rivers; amending Resolution 25789 and K. C. C. Title 21.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Flood Hazard Area as shown and defined on the zoning maps described below and attached hereto are hereby adopted pursuant to the provisions of King County Resolution No. 25789, Ordinance 1527 and K. C. C. Title 21 as follows:

That portion of unincorporated King County:

- A. Maple Valley and Enumclaw: Township 22 North, Range 6 East; less County and State Roads.
- B. Lower Snoqualmie: The East 1/2 of Township 26 North, Range 6 East, except Sections 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34. Also except the West 1/2 of Section 2, West 1/2 of Section 11, West 1/2 of Section 26 and West 1/2 of Section 35. Also except that portion incorporated into Duvall; less County and State Roads.
- West 1/2 Township 26 North, Range 7 East; less County and State Roads.
- Township 25 North, Range 7 East, except that portion incorporated into Carnation; less County and State Roads.
- Township 24 North, Range 7 East, except Sections 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36; less County and State Roads.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 16th day of April, 1973.
