ORDINANCE NO. 1931

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$42,636 from the Executive Contingency to the Cedar Hills Alcoholism Treatment Center for a female alcoholism treatment program and also for a selected patient thirty-day treatment program; amending Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$42,636 to the Cedar Hills Alcoholism Treatment Center from the Executive Contingency is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:




