

ORDINANCE NO. 1934

AN ORDINANCE correcting manifest errors in the 1974 budget, appropriating funds in Special Programs and amending Ordinance No. 1859, Sections 2, 3 and 7.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$31,248 for Seattle-King County Legal Aid, \$15,000 for the Bi-Centennial Commission, \$54,933 for adjustments to the Road Fund budget from the Executive Contingency, and \$6,000 for the Active Mexicanos Service Center.


