ORDINANCE NO. 1944

AN ORDINANCE establishing an Alcoholism Fund and appropriating \$100,251 from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services and \$26,450 from the Commission on Alcoholism administrative support in the Current Expense Fund, for alcoholism services in King County, amending Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$126,701 to the Alcoholism Fund, \$100,251 from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services and \$26,450 from the Commission on Alcoholism administrative support in the Current Expense Fund, for alcoholism services in King County, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Alcoholism ((\$-0-)) \$126,701

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
