ORDINANCE NO. 1946

AN ORDINANCE relating to rodent control, requiring preventive measures and prescribing penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 .

SECTION 1. All premises shall, at all times, be kept free from rodents. The Director of the Seattle-King County Health Department, or his appointed representative, shall be permitted access to such premises for the purpose of ascertaining the presence of rodents. The director may enter such premises at reasonable times to inspect the same: provided that (i) if the premises is occupied, the director shall first present proper credentials and demand entry; and (ii) if the premises is unoccupied the director shall first make a reasonable effort to locate the owner or other person (s) having charge or control of the premises and demand entry.

No person shall fail or neglect, after proper demand, to admit the director or interfere with the director in the performance of his duty.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for the owner or occupant of any premises to fail to reconstruct or repair such premises including residences, for the purpose of preventing rats, mice or other rodents from gaining entrance thereto. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any food or food products, goods, wares or merchandise in such premises to fail to adequately protect the same to prevent rodents from gaining access to or coming in contact therewith.

If rodents are found to be present, the owner or occupant of the premises shall apply such reasonable measures for the eradication as approved by the director.
