AN ORDINANCE declaring the abandonment of the Forward Thrust Park and Recreation Project known as Shoreline Community Beach and providing for the transfer of monies appropriated therefor; amending Resolution No. 34571 and the 1974 Parks Capital Improvement Sub-program Ordinance No. 1859, Section 8, Attachment 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 5 of King County Resolution No. 34571, the County finds that the Forward Thrust Park and Recreation Project known as Shoreline Community Beach and identified in Section 3G(4) of said Resolution cannot be satisfactorily accomplished.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 6 of King County Resolution No. 34571 and the above finding, the transfer of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$260,000) from said project account to the Forward Thrust Park and Recreation project known as Northeast Lake Washington and identified in Section 3G(5) of said resolution, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 3. The Shoreline Community Beach Capital Improvement project No. 060141 is hereby declared abandoned with appropriated project funds in the amount of \$260,000 being transferred to the Northeast Lake Washington Capital Improvement Project No. 060051.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 8, Attachment 1, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
