

ORDINANCE NO. 1955

AN ORDINANCE relating to the County Capital Budget and Program, accelerating the appropriation of funds from 1975 to 1974 for the Burton Acres Addition Project and revising the 1974 Park Capital Improvement Sub-Program Budget; amending Ordinance No. 1859, Sections 7 and 8, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$50,000 for the Burton Acres Addition Project.






