

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Holiday Park to Lakehaven Sewer District.

WHEREAS, Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for an election on the annexation of an area known as Holiday Park to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires the approval of the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board before the setting of a special election to submit the proposal to the qualified electors within the territory to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for sewer facilities, and of benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Holiday Park and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to results of a special election to be held within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 2. The Holiday Park to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 5, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 5 to the intersection with the centerline of Dash Point Road;

Thence Easterly and Northerly along the centerline of Dash Point Road to the intersection with the East line of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 5;

Thence Southerly along said East line to the South line of said Section 5;

1 Thence Westerly along the South line of Section 5 to
2 the Northeast corner of Lot 7, Plat of Holiday Park
No. 2 as recorded in Volume 68 page 75, records of King
County, Washington;

3 Thence Southerly along the East line and Southerly
4 extension thereof to the centerline of South 304th
Place;

5 Thence Westerly along the centerline of South 304th
6 Place to the intersection with the Northerly extension
7 of the East line of Lot 8 of said plat of Holiday Park
No. 2;

8 Thence Southerly along the East line of said Lot 8
9 and the Northerly extension thereof to the Southeast
corner of said Lot 8;

10 Thence Westerly along the South line of said Lot 8
11 to the Northeast corner of Lot 10 of said plat;

12 Thence Southerly along the East line of said plat of
Holiday Park No. 2 and continuing Southerly along
13 the East line of the plat of Holiday Park No. 3 as
recorded in Volume 72, page 35, records of King County,
14 Washington to the Southeast corner of Lot 28 of said
plat of Holiday Park No. 3;

15 Thence Southwesterly across South 308th to the Northeast
16 corner of Lot 29 of said plat of Holiday Park No. 3;

17 Thence Southerly to the Southeast corner of Lot 30
of said plat of Holiday Park No. 3;

18 Thence Easterly along the South line of Lot 20 of the
19 Plat of Emberwood No. 3 as recorded in Volume 73,
Page 8, records of King County, Washington to the East
20 line of West half of the Southwest quarter of the
Northwest quarter of Section 8, Township 21 North,
21 Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

22 Thence Southerly along said East line to the Southeast
23 corner of the West half of the Southwest quarter of
the Northwest quarter of said Section 8;

24 Thence Southerly along the East line of the West half
25 of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of
said Section 8 to the Southeast corner thereof;

26 Thence Westerly along the South line of the West half
27 of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of
said Section 8 to the West line of said Section 8;


1 Thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 8
2 to the Point of Beginning.


