2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Civil Service
3 Commission; prescribing requirements for
4 the establishment of personnel rules and
5 the responsibility of the King County
6 Personnel Division in administering the
7 provisions of RCW 41.14.050; amending
8 Ordinance 1134, Sections 2 and 4, and
9 K.C.C. 3.14.020, 3.14.040.

10 SECTION 1. Ordinance 1134, Section 2, and K.C.C. 3.14.020
11 are hereby amended as follows:

12 The Civil Service Commission, hereinafter referred to as
13 the Commission, will consist of three members. The Commission
14 shall present a proposed ordinance establishing the personnel
15 rules to the County Council, no later than June 15, 1974,
16 provided that, until such rules are adopted by the County
17 Council, no promotional examinations will be held for the rank
18 of sergeant or above.² The rules so adopted by the County
19 Council shall not be applied so as to decrease or eliminate any
20 of the rights, privileges and protections granted to the deputy
21 sheriff's civil service system.

22 SECTION 2. Ordinance 1134, Section 4, K.C.C. 3.14.040, are
23 hereby amended as follows:

24 ~~((The Department of Personnel shall provide a list of qualified~~
25 ~~applicants after competitive examination for the position of~~
26 ~~chief examiner from which the commission shall appoint one who~~
27 ~~shall serve as its secretary, and such assistants as may be~~
28 ~~necessary to keep the records for the Commission, preserve all~~






