AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Jones to Des Moines Sewer District.

WHEREAS, Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Jones to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for sewer facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as Jones and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

The area known as Jones to be annexed is SECTION 2. described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of the NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., with the centerline of Railroad St. (10th Ave. S.) of Des Moines Water Front Addition to the Town of Des Moines, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 4 of plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington.

Thence Southerly along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Washington Ave. (S. 242nd St.) as shown on said plat,

Thence Westerly along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Marine View Drive,

Thence Northerly along said centerline to its intersection with the said North line of the NE 1/4,

1	Thence Easterly along said North line to its inter- section with the centerline of said Railroad St. (10th Ave. S.) and the Point of Beginning.
