ORDINANCE NO. 2008

AN ORDINANCE establishing a Manpower Consortium Fund.

WHEREAS, the County is in a position to share its automated accounting systems with other agencies and King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium wishes to have certain functions related to financial accounting processed by the County at a service charge equal to the cost of rendering the services. Whereas, the County has entered into an agreement with King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium to provide such services.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A Manpower Consortium Fund is hereby established to account for the funds which belong to King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium.

SECTION 2. The assets and liabilities of said fund are those of the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium and are distinct from the assets and liabilities of King County.

SECTION 3. King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium will deposit to the County Comptroller, on a regular basis, sufficient funds to cover disbursements to be made by the County on behalf of the Consortium. In the event there are not sufficient fund deposits in the County Comptroller's Office by the Consortium to cover its disbursements, the County shall not obligate its own funds to cover the Consortium disbursements.
