ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of LILLIAN LEE McGRATH, Division of Land Use Management File No. 115-72-P.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. LILLIAN LEE McGRATH petitioned on April 27, 1972 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS-7200 (Potential RM-2400) to RM-2400 and this application was assigned Division of Land Use Management file No. 115-72-P.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Division of Land Use Management was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on May 30, 1972 and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter June 6, 1972. The report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on June 21, 1972 with Motion No. 850.

SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King County Zoning Code, Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B above, to RM-2400 and

directs that Area Map E-16-26-4 be	modified to so designate.
