## ORDINANCE NO. 2124

AN ORDINANCE calling a special election for the formation of Fire Protection District No. 50 in the vicinity of Skykomish, King County, Washington, declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. That the formation of a Fire Protection District will be conducive to the public safety, welfare and convenience, and will be of special benefit to the land included wi thin the boundaries of such district, as hereinafter described.

SECTION 2. That the name and number of said dis trict shall be King County Fire Protection District No. 50, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner section 3, T. 26 N., R. 10 E., WLM., thence southerly along the west section lines of sections 3, 10, 15, 22, 27, 34 to the southwest corner of section 34, T. 26 N., R 10 E., W.M., then east along the township line between Townships 25 N. and 26 N. to the King-Chelan County line, thence north along the King-Chelan County line to the King-Snohomish County line, thence west along the King-Snohomish County line to point of Beginning.
