AN ORDINANCE relating to annual submission of junior taxing district budgets to the King County Council.

ATTEST:

SECTION 1. The junior taxing districts of King County shall annually certify to the King County Council on or before the Wednesday next following the first Monday in October in each year the amount of levies to be made in support of their district for the ensuing year in total and by individual fund.

SECTION 2. The certification required in Section 1 shall in all cases be a formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners and shall include the information required on the form appended to this ordinance in the format shown.

SECTION 3. Copies of the resolution shall be forwarded by registered mail to the Clerk of the King County Council and the King County Assessor.

SECTION 4. The King County Assessor shall annually certify to junior taxing districts in King County the assessed valuation of property lying withing the boundaries of the district for the ensuing year's tax levy by the third Monday after the first Friday in September.
