AN ORDINANCE adopting a comprehensive sanitary sewage transmittal and disposal plan for King County and setting a date for a public hearing.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with 36.94 R.C.W. a County Sewerage Plan Review Committee has been selected and organized. This Committee has met and has conducted a review of a report entitled "Metropolitan Seattle Sewerage and Drainage Survey," (hereinafter called the "Report") setting forth a recommended long term comprehensive sewage transmittal and disposal plan for the urbanized area of the County. The Committee has reviewed and studied fourteen amendments to said Report, previously adopted by the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle. The Report has been widely disseminated among the cities and special districts of the County and has been approved by the State of Washington regulatory agencies. The Committee, by means of its Resolution No. 74-1, recommends that the Council of the County of King adopt the "Metropolitan Seattle Sewerage and Drainage Survey," together with its amendments, as the comprehensive sewerage plan for the County;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The following described portions of the "Metropolitan Seattle Sewerage and Drainage Survey" prepared by consulting engineers, Brown and Caldwell, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Council and by this reference is made a part hereof, be and they hereby are approved as the comprehensive sewage disposal plan for King County;

- A. The plan of sanitary sewerage facilities depicted in Figure 15-19 and generally described in Chapter 15 of the Report;
- B. The design criteria set forth in Chapter 13 of the Report;
- C. The amendments to the Report as set forth in Resolutsions No. 23, No. 74, No. 152, No. 261, No. 441, No. 447, No. 795, No. 928, No. 1011, No. 1024, No. 1052, No. 1257, No. 1330, No. 1829, and No. 2025 as adopted by the Council of the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle.

SECTION 2: All persons who may desire to object to adoption of the sewerage comprehensive plan are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the King County

the City of Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the 19th day of 2 August, 1974, at which time and place is fixed for hearing of 3 matters relating to adoption of said plan. ## RESOLUTION NO. 2181

A RESOLUTION of the Council of the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle approving a proposed Ordinance for the adoption of a comprehensive sanitary sewage transmission and disposal plan for King County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to public vote and Chapter 35.58 RCW, the Municipality is authorized to perform the function of metropolitan water pollution abatement for the Seattle-King County Metropolitan Area, including metropolitan sewage disposal; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 36.94 RCW, a County Sewerage Plan Review Committee has recommended that King County adopt the sewage disposal portion of the Municipality's Comprehensive Sewage Disposal and Storm Water Drainage Plan as a comprehensive sewerage plan for the County to enable the development of local sewerage service by the County; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.94.040 requires such sewerage general plan of the County incorporate the provisons of the Municipality's comprehensive plan and that the Municipality approve said County plan prior to adoption by the County; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Municipality and the County that their respective comprehensive plans relating to sewage transmission and disposal be consistent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle that the proposed King County Ordinance No. 74-645 substantiated in the form of Exhibit "A" attached hereto adopting a sewerage general plan for King County is hereby approved.
