

ORDINANCE NO. 2180

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a
3 portion of N.E. 104th, 204th Ave. N.E., and
4 202nd Ave. N.E. Petitioner: Overlake School.
5 V-1466.

6 WHEREAS, a petition has been filed requesting vacation of a
7 portion of N.E. 104th, 204th Ave. N.E. and 202nd Ave. N.E. herein-
8 after described, and

9 WHEREAS, the report of the Department of Public Works and
10 Transportation and the Department of Community and Environmental
11 Development, Land Use Management Division, finds that the road to
12 be vacated is useless to the County, and the vacation would not be
13 in conflict with the principles and purposes of the Comprehensive
14 Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation,
15 and

16 WHEREAS, due notice was given in the manner provided by law
17 and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 30th day
18 of September, 1974, and

19 WHEREAS, in consideration of the benefits to be derived from
20 the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the
21 best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition,

22 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

23 SECTION 1

24 The King County Council requests the appropriate department
25 work out a plan whereby the Overlake School may pay for the cost of
26 the vacation as described below over a period of five years.

27 SECTION 2


28 The Council on the 30th day of September, 1974, hereby vacates
29 and abandons the portion of N.E. 104th, 204th Ave. N.E. and 202nd
30 Ave. N.E. described as follows:

1 All that portion of N.E. 104th Street lying Easterly
2 of the West line of Tract 31, Block 78, Supplemental
3 Plat of Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Addition to the
4 City of Seattle, Division No. 24, as recorded in
5 Volume 22 of Plats, Page 13, Records of King County,
6 Washington and lying Westerly of the East line of
7 Tract 39, Block 77 of said plat; ALSO the West 30
8 feet of 204th Avenue N.E. lying Northerly of the
9 Easterly extension of the South line of said Supple-
10 mental Plat of Burke & Farrar's described above and
11 lying Southerly of the South right of way margin of
12 N.E. 108th Street; ALSO all that portion of 202nd
13 Avenue N.E. lying Southerly of the Westerly extension
14 of the North line of said Tract 39 and lying Northerly
15 of the North right of way margin of herein described
16 N.E. 104th Street.

18 September, 1974.


