ORDINANCE NO. . . 2182

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Welchko, et al to King County Water District No. 58.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 58 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Welchko, et al to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

The annexation by King County Water District No. 58 of the area known as Welchko, et al and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

The area known as Welchko, et al to be annexed SECTION 2. is described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along the North line of said Subdivision to an intersection with a line that is 180 feet West of and parallel to the East line of the Southwest quarter of of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16, said intersection being the True Point of Beginning;

Thence Southerly along said parallel line to the South line of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16;

Thence Westerly along said South line to the Southwest corner of the East half of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16;

Thence Northerly along the West line of said subdivision to the North line of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16;
