

ORDINANCE NO. 2202

AN ORDINANCE amending the appeal provisions of zoning enforcement procedures and amending Ordinance 1219, Section 401(a) and K.C.C. 21.69.170.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1219, Section 401(a) and K.C.C. 21.69.170 are hereby amended to read as follows:

"FORM. Any person entitled to service under K.C.C. 21.69.120 may appeal from any notice and order or any action of the director of building under this title by filing at the office of the director of building within (~~thirty~~) fifteen days from the date of the service of such order, a written appeal containing:

(1) A heading in the words: "Before the Board of Appeals of the County of King";

(2) A caption reading: "Appeal of \_\_\_\_\_" giving the names of all appellants participating in the appeal;

(3) A brief statement setting forth the legal interest of each of the appellants in the building, structure, premises, land, or portion thereof involved in the notice and order;

(4) A brief statement in concise language of the specific order or action protested, together with any material facts claimed to support the contentions of the appellant;

(5) A brief statement in concise language of the relief sought, and the reasons why it is claimed the protested order or action should be reversed, modified, or otherwise set aside;


1 (6) The signatures of all parties named as appellants and  
2 their official mailing addresses;

3 (7) The verification (by declaration under penalty of per-  
4 jury) of at least one appellant as to the truth of the matters  
5 stated in the appeal."




