

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to reallocation of
2 appropriations in the 1974 Annual Budget;
3 transferring \$25,000 from Executive Con-
4 tingency to the Division of Facilities
5 Management for emergency repairs; amending
6 Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended;
7 and declaring an emergency.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. An additional appropriation in the amount of
10 \$25,000 from Executive Contingency to the Division of Facilities
11 Management for emergency repairs of exterior metal grills in the
12 King County Automotive Center is hereby approved and adopted.

13 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 2, as amended, is
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 Executive Administration:



20 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for
21 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety for
22 the support of county government and its existing public insti-
23 tutions.




