AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an agreement to transfer Forward Thrust funds designated for that portion of the 148th Avenue Widening Project extending from S.E. 28th Street to N.E. 8th Street to the City of Bellevue, Washington, and authorizing the transfer of funds.

PREAMBLE:

R

The City of Bellevue has since annexed that portion of 148th Avenue, extending from S.E. 28th Street to N.E. 8th Street, for which Forward Thrust funds, (in the amount of \$196,000), were originally designated to King County as part of its arterial program. By Resolution No. 1608, the City of Bellevue has resolved to assume responsibility of said street widening project. King County will execute an agreement with the City of Bellevue to transfer \$196,000 from King County's account to the City of Bellevue for use in the 148th Street Widening Project, extending from S.E. 28th Street to N.E. 8th Street

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the City of Bellevue to transfer \$196,000 from the King County Arterial Highway Fund to the City of Bellevue to widen 148th Avenue extending from S.E. 28th Street to N.E. 8th Street consistent with the provisions of King County Resolution No. 34569.

SECTION 2: The King County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer \$196,000 from King County to the City of Bellevue for use on the 148th Avenue Widening Project, extending from S.E. 28th Street to N.E. 8th Street.
