

ORDINANCE NO. 2251

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Loveland to King County Water District No. 82.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Loveland to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Loveland and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Loveland to be annexed is described as follows:


That portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W.M., lying southerly of the centerline of the Inglewood Hill Road in King County, Washington, EXCEPT any portion of the South 200 feet of the Southeast Quarter of said Northeast Quarter, and EXCEPT any portion of the North 100 feet

of the South 300 feet of the East 300 feet of said Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, King County, Washington.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 18th day of November, 1974.


