

ORDINANCE NO. 2252

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as Highline School District #401 from King County Water District #49.

WHEREAS, King County Water District #49 has found the petition for withdrawal of an area known as Highline School District #401 to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed withdrawal by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said withdrawal is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District #49 of the area known as Highline School District #401 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.


SECTION 2. The area known as Highline School District #401 to be withdrawan is described as follows:

That portion of the S½ of the NW¼ of the NE¼ of Sec. 32, T. 23 N., R 4 E. W.M., in King County, Washington, lying Westerly of the West Margin of SR 509.




