AN ORDINANCE creating a Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund, providing for the capitalization and accumulation of reserves for equipment replacement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the "Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund."

SECTION 2. The Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund shall be used to account for the assets, liabilities, revenues and expenditures of the Systems Services Division of the Department of Executive Administration in accordance with County Ordinance, State law and Municipal Finance Officers Association dictates regarding operation of Intra-Governmental Service Funds including recovery from income of the complete costs of operations including depreciation and overhead.

SECTION 3. The fixed assets including computer equipment presently owned by King County and held in the custody of the Systems Services Division is hereby transferred from the Current Expense Fund to the Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund as a contribution upon which to begin operation.

SECTION 4. In addition to the contribution set out in Section 3 above, the County Executive is authorized to make a loan from the Current Expense Fund or other County Fund from which funds may be available to the Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund as working capital.

SECTION 5. There shall be accumulated within the Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund liquid assets equal to depreciation reserves and maintained thereafter to be used only for replacement of capital assets.

SECTION 6. The operation of the Intra-Governmental Service Fund, its financial status and prospects shall be reviewed quarterly with the appropriate Committee of the Council. In the event that a decision is made to replace County-owned computer fixed assets by a means other than purchase, the accumulated liquid assets arising from depreciation of said assets or any other fund balance not required for operation shall be transferred to the Current Expense Fund as a return of the contribution of the Current Expense Fund to the Systems Services Intra-Governmental Service Fund.
