ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of  
2 \$36,825 to the Grant Fund for the  
3 Youthful Offender Program and amending  
4 Ordinance No. 2230, Section 60, as  
5 amended, and declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. The amount of \$34,984 is hereby appropriated to  
8 the Grant Fund from the Washington State Law and Justice Planning  
9 Office, Grant No. 1542, as State Buy-In for the Youthful Offender  
10 Program, County File No. 501/45.

11 SECTION 2. The amount of \$1,841 is hereby appropriated to  
12 the Grant Fund from the Department of Public Safety's Current  
13 Expense Budget as cash match in support of the Youthful Offender  
14 Program, County File No. 501/45.

15 SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 60, as amended, is  
16 hereby amended to read as follows: From the Grant Fund there is  
17 hereby appropriated: (~~2,054,750~~) \$2,091,575

18 PROVIDED THAT:

- 19 1) \$136,250 shall be expended only to reimburse the  
20 Current Expense Fund for Systems Services New  
21 Development.

22 SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares  
23 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary  
24 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety  
25 or for the support of county government and its existing public  
26 institutions.
