ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the District Courts, Juvenile Court, Department of Public Safety; amending Ordinance 2230, Section 28, 45, 46.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2230, Section 28 is hereby amended as follows:

<u>Public Safety</u> - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Safety

\$8,808,088

PROVIDED THAT:

- ((1)) ((Position-7410-0005-in-the-Supervision-and Administrative-Support-Program-Element-(10102) shall-be-eliminated-from-the-1975-budget.))
- 1) ((2)) The Department shall review and report to the Operations and Judiciary Committee regarding combining the responsibilities of the Legal Advisor and the position of Administrative Assistant in Policy Directions Program Element in the 1975 budget.
- 2) ((3)) A quarterly accounting shall be made to the Operations and Judiciary Committee of reimbursables to the EOC operation from various grant agencies;
- 3) ((4)) Uniformed Patrol Operation strength shall remain consistent at 225 man years throughout 1975;
- 4) ((5)) The Department shall confer with the Health and Safety Committee prior to engaging a consultant on efficiency.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2230, Section 45 is hereby amended as follows:
