

ORDINANCE NO. 2292

AN ORDINANCE relating to the appeal of taxpayers' claims for relief of taxes and assessments on real or personal property destroyed by fire or act of God.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Decisions of the King County Assessor in taxpayer claims for relief of taxes and assessments on real or personal property destroyed by fire or act of God as provided for in Chapter 196 Laws of 1974, 1st Extraordinary Session shall in the event the taxpayer wishes to appeal, be first appealed to the Board of Appeals; PROVIDED THAT the decision of the Board of Appeals may be appealed to the King County Council. The decision of the Council shall be final.
