

ORDINANCE NO. 2230

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$14,000 for the purpose of providing fire inspection service due to the impact of Chapter 96, Laws of 1974 State of Washington to the Building Division from unanticipated receipts, amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 22, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An amount of \$14,000 is hereby appropriated to the Building Division to fund a fire inspector required to comply with Chapter 96, Laws of 1974, State of Washington.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 22, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

BUILDING ((905,191)) \$919,191

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) Within this appropriation the Building Division Manager shall develop a procedure for processing applications for permits that minimizes the time required, maximizes the feedback to the applicant relative to status, and to the maximum degree possible, provides the applicant with a "one-stop" process and consider an expeditor to assure timely processing; If necessary, such a process may require additional copies of data from the applicant to allow simultaneous processing by separate involved agencies; Such developed procedure shall be reported for review by the Council's Committee on Community and Environmental Development on or before January 31, 1975.
