AN ORDINANCE relating to the Code of Ethics and situations deemed a conflict of interest; amending Ordinance 2184, Section 2 and K.C.C. 3.04.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2184, Section 2 and K.C.C. 3.04 are hereby amended as follows:

DISCLOSURE OF INCOME AND INVESTMENTS. All persons appointed by the County Executive, to include Board and Commission members, all persons appointed by the County Administrator which are subject to the approval of the County Executive, all employees of the Council, and such other public employees as may be determined by the Board of Ethics, shall file with the Board of Ethics within ten days of employment or appointment and on or before January 31 of each year a written statement of:

- (1) All sources of income in excess of \$1,500 per year; and
- (2) The name of any corporation, firm or enterprise in which he or she has a direct financial interest in excess of \$1,500; PROVIDED, that policies of insurance issued to himself or herself, or spouse, accounts in banks, savings and loan associations or credit unions, are not to be considered financial interest; and
- (3) Every office or directorship held by the employee, his or her spouse, or any member of his or her family in any corporation, association, firm or enterprise, both profit and non-profit, doing business in King County; and
- (4) A list by legal description or popular address of all real property owned in KING County by the employee, his or her spouse, or member of the family, including options to buy if the property is valued in excess of \$1,500; and
- (5) With respect to attorneys or others practicing before state and local regulatory agencies during the preceding twelve-

1 month period, the name, the agency or agencies and the name of  
2 the firm, partnership or association in which the person is a  
3 member, partner or employee and the gross compensation in excess  
4 of \$1,500 received by the attorney and the firm, partnership or  
5 association respectively for such practice before such regulatory  
6 agency; and

7 (6) All candidates for County elective office shall within  
8 two weeks of becoming a candidate, as defined by R.C.W. 42.17.020,  
9 and all elected officials, paid in whole or in part County funds  
10 shall file with the Board of Ethics on or before January 31st of  
11 each year, a Code of Ethics Financial Statement, which includes  
12 items one (1) through five (5) above. This requirement may be  
13 satisfied by filing with the Board of Ethics a copy of the report  
14 required to be filed by R.C.W. 42.17.240 commonly referred to as  
15 Form F-1, if this form contains an original signature of the  
16 person filing the report.

17 PROVIDED, with the exception of (6), that statements due to  
18 be filed no later than January 31, 1975 shall be filed no later  
19 than February 21, 1975.
