## ORDINANCE NO. 2302

AN ORDINANCE relating to For-Hire Driver's; amending Ordinance 1120, Section 31 and K.C.C. 6.64.310.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1120, Section 31 and K.C.C. 6.64.310 are hereby amended as follows:

Qualifications for a for-hire driver's license. No person shall be issued a for-hire driver's license unless he possesses the following qualifications:

- (A) Must be at least eighteen years of age;
- (B) Must be a bona fide resident of the state of Washington for at least six months prior to filing application;
- (C) Must possess a valid state of Washington Motor Vehicle Operator's License;
- (D) Must be free from any infirmity of body or mind which would render the applicant unfit for safe operation of a motor vehicle and shall have submitted to a medical examination by ((the Scattle King County health department)) a licensed physician and ((have obtained)) file with the director a certificate from ((the efficer)) said physician certifying his fitness as such for-hire driver: The scope of the examination and the certificate form shall be prescribed by the Scattle-King County health department. Such examination ((certificate)) shall not be required for renewals of such license, but the director may at any time at his discretion require any licensee to be so examined and to secure such a certificate or renewal thereof;
