SUBSTITUTE
ORDINANCE NO. **2303**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$41,700 for the purpose of providing staff due to the unanticipated increase in new construction activity to the Building Division from unanticipated revenue, amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 22.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An amount of \$41,700 is hereby appropriated from unanticipated revenue to the Building Division to fund staff required due to unanticipated increases in new construction activity in 1975.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 22, is hereby amended to read as follows: From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to

Building ((905,191)) \$946,891

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) Within this appropriation the Building Division Manager shall develop a procedure for processing applications for permits that minimizes the time required, maximizes the feedback to the applicant relative to status, and to the maximum degree possible, provides the applicant with a "one-stop" process and consider an expeditor to assure timely processing; if necessary, such a process may require additional copies of data from the applicant, to allow simultaneous processing by separate involved agencies; such developed procedure shall be reported for review by the Council's Committee on Community and Environmental Development on or before January 31, 1975.
