ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste administrative operations, defining service fee collection policies, authorizing cash payments, monthly payment bonds, and late payment penalties; amending Section 3, Ordinance 800 as amended and K.C.C. 10.12.030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Section 3, Ordinance 800 and K.C.C. 10.12.030 is amended to read as follows:

All service fees collected pursuant to this chapter shall be collected in cash by site cashiers at the time of use; provided, that the manager of the King County Solid Waste Division, Department of Public Works and Transportation may authorize a commercial or noncommercial user to be billed monthly for all solid waste delivered to the transfer stations and/or final disposal sites.

Authorization of a commercial or noncommercial user's monthly billing shall result from a request in advance for such service by the commercial or noncommercial user; provided, that no authorization shall be granted without the posting of an irrevocable payment bond secured by the commercial or noncommercial user in the name of the Solid Waste Division and in an amount which is equal to the actual prior three months of user fee charges. In the absence of prior usage charges, an estimate by the commercial or noncommercial user of three months of usage charges will determine the bond amount. The amount of such bond may be changed by giving of thirty day notice by the manager to reflect actual usage.

All invoiced fees shall be due and payable to King County, Solid Waste Division, in monthly installments on or before the last day of each billing month. A late ((eharge)) payment penalty equal to ((the-legal-rate-ef-interest)) one percent (1%) of the delinquent unpaid balance, compounded monthly, shall be assessed on the delinquent unpaid balance of those nongovernmental commercial and noncommercial accounts in arrears. The manager, having given seven days notice, may suspend use privileges for a commercial or noncommercial user who fails to tender payment within two months in arrears.

1	A noncommercial user may be authorized by the manager to be
2	billed monthly for all solid waste delivered to the transfer stations
3	and for final disposal sites; provided, that such noncommercial user
4 :	is either: (1) A municipal corporation, governmental department,
5	agency or commission, or political subdivision; or (2) a person whose
6	monthly service charges exceed one hundred dollars.
