The \$68,200 is appropriated in order to provide the Clerk of the King County Superior Court the money necessary for disbursement to the Weyerhaeuser Company in the amount of \$55,000 and to the Bryant Corporation in the amount of \$13,200 in settlement of the claims of said corporations against King County, Weyerhaeuser v.
