AN ORDINANCE relating to Rules and Order of Business of the King County Council, amending Ord. 1420, Sec. 2, Urd. 1482, Sec. 1, Ord. 1373, Sec. 17, and K.C.C.1.24.170.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1420, Section 2, Ordinance 1482, Section 1, Ordinance 1373, Section 17, and K.C.C. 1.24.170 are hereby amended as follows:

Standing committees. The chairman of the council shall appoint the chairman, vice chairman and the membership of the standing committees, with consent of a majority of the council members.

The standing committees are established as follows:

- (1) ((Health-and-Safety)) Health and Human Services Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters relating to health, welfare, ((police-and-fire-protection;-air-and-water pollution;-and-civil-defense;-and-on-all-matters-concerning-building-permits; building-eodes;-and-other-technical-codes-and-regulations)) and human resource programs of the county including human service functional planning and programming.
- (2) ((Gemmunity-and-Environmental-Development)) Planning and Community

  Development Five Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters pertaining to ((Gemprehensive-plans;-urban-renewal-and-zening-within-the-Geunty;-en-matters-pertaining-te-Geunty-parks-and-ether-recreational facilities-and-pregram-and-public-epen-space-and-related-public-community service)) comprehensive planning within the County, including long range and community plans, functional plans for housing, parks and recreation, transportation, economic development, shoreline management, open space, air and water quality; to consider and report on all matters pertaining to zoning and other land use development controls.
- (3) ((Budget-and-Long-Range-Planning)) Finance, Audit and Budget Four or More Members. Function: to recommend budget objectives and priorities
  and schedule for the Council's review of the yearly Executive budget proposal;
  to consider and make recommendations on all matters and legislation of a
  financial nature, including appropriations, expenditures ((and)), the selling

of bonds and investment policies; and on all matters relating to the levying of taxes; to investigate and report on all financial claims filed against the county; to examine requests for changes in assessments and taxes; to receive and examine reports of the County and State Auditor and submit such recommendations to the County Council as it deems necessary or desirable in connection with the subject matter of such reports; and coordinate Council overview of the economy, efficiency and effectiveness of all County departments and programs.

- (4) Inter-Governmental Relations Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters of joint interest between ((the-eounty-and-federal-government;-state-of-Washington;-eities-and municipalities-within-the-eounty;-other-counties;-and-other-governmental agencies)) the County and (a) other counties, the state of Washington and the federal government, (b) the city of Seattle and other towns and municipalities within the county, and (c) other government agencies such as Metro, the Puget Sound Council of Governments and Central Puget Sound Economic Development District.
- (5) ((Operations-and-Judiciary)) Operations, Police and Judiciary Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on matters relating to ((salaries; -wages; -and-working-conditions of Gounty-employees;)) county personnel and governmental organization; ((to-investigate-and-report upon-the-efficiency-of-all-Gounty-departments-and-the-operations-development thereof;)) to oversee and receive reports from the Office of Citizens' Complaints ((and-the-Gounty-Auditor)); to consider and make recommendations on all matters relating to County records and elections; to consider and make recommendations on all matters relating to amendment of the County Charter; to consider and make recommendations on all matters relating to the criminal justice system, including law, safety, and justice, functional planning and programming.
- (6) ((Public Works and Transportation)) Public Facilities and Utilities Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all
  matters ((pertaining)) relating to the construction and maintenance of the
  County road and park system, ((and-other-transportation-facilities,)) and on

1	all matters ((pertaining-to-other-Gounty-construction,-solid-waste,-public
2	works,-and-utilities)) concerning public facilities, solid waste, surface
3	water, fire protection and utilities, including public facilities and utilities;
4	to consider and make recommendations on all matters concerning building permits.
5	building codes and other technical codes and regulations.
