AN ORDINANCE establishing a King County Emergency Medical Services Review Committee, defining its composition, duties and powers.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

There is hereby created a King County Emergency SECTION 1. Medical Services Review Committee, hereinafter referred to as the Committee.

SECTION 2. The Committee shall consist of six members; the three members of the County Board of Health, one Mayor of an incorporated city of town of King County other than the City of Seattle, one commissioner of a Fire Protection District of King County, and a commissioner of an operating Hospital District of King County.

Members of the Committee, other than the members of the County Board of Health, shall be appointed by the County Executive subject to confirmation by the County Council and shall serve terms of three years.

The Committee Chairman shall be the Chairman of the County Board of Health.

SECTION 3. Members of the Committee shall be residents of King County throughout their term and shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 4. The Committee shall be responsible for reviewing the applications of emergency medical service provider groups for funds or training services which King County may make available for the improvement of emergency medical services in the County and shall recommend the approval or denial of such applications to the County Council.

Applications may be submitted by a jurisdiction or group of jurisdictions acting in consort responsible or potentially responsible for the provision of emergency medical services within sub-county regions hereinafter referred to as

Emergency Medical Service Areas

The boundaries of Emergency Medical Service

Areas shall be defined by the Committee with proper regard

being given to actual and potential response times, existing or

planned dispatch/ communications arrangements and the availability

of viable mutual aid agreements.

Council for their adoption rules and procedures for the review of applications. These rules and procedures shall place emphasis on the County's desire to have as quickly as possible a paramedic level of service available in those areas of the County where this is medically feasible. Further, the Committee shall seek to insure maximum cooperation among service providers and to foster compliance with necessary medical standards.

All rules and procedures recommended by the Committee and adopted by the Council shall be made public as currently and hereafter amended.

SECTION 5. The County Health Officer or his duly authorized representative, shall serve as Executive Secretary of the Committee and will be responsible for all records.

The Committee may adopt such administrative procedures as are required to accomplish the purposes of this ordinance.

Four members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum and a majority of such quorum may secure approval of a transaction of the Committee.
