ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of Roman C. Pergiel, Division of Land Use Management File No. 200-74-P.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Roman C. Pergiel petitioned on November 14, 1973, that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from SR & SR (Pot. C-G) to M-L and this application was assigned Division of Land Use Management File No. 200-74-P.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Division of Land Use Management was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on January 22, 1974 and March 19, 1974, and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter January 29, 1974 and March 26, 1974. The report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on April 10, 1974, and the Council approved the reclassification by Motion No. 1553 on May 13, 1974, subject to conditions which have now been satisfied.

SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King County Zoning Code, Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B above to M-L and
